### Pedestrian Path and Pedestrian Safety:

- Pedestrians can use the temporary asphalt sidewalk on the west side of Glendale Ave, from York Rd heading towards the on and off ramps from the QEW Toronto Bound. See Figure 2
- At the traffic signals for the on and off ramps to QEW Toronto Bound, pedestrians should cross to the east side of Glendale Ave to use the existing sidewalk to continue to head South. See Figure 3
- Pedestrians can continue heading south on the east side of Glendale Ave following the pedestrian path between the temporary construction fence and existing sidewalks to get to Taylor Road. See Figure 4
- Use designated crossing spots and take additional measures, such as making eye contact with drivers when crossing in front of vehicles
